



# Enrichment Opportunities 2019-2020

## UW Robinson Center for Young Scholars

The mission of the Halbert and Nancy Robinson Center for Young Scholars (RC) at the University of Washington is threefold: teaching, research, and service. The RC is a leader in the nation for developing programs that serve highly capable young pre-college and college students. We are committed to increasing access and fostering student potential among students historically marginalized and excluded from advanced learning opportunities.

### Saturday Program

#### GRADES K-8

Saturday classes are intended to provide intellectually ambitious students with challenge, inspiration, and fun, in a collaborative, supportive learning environment. Our classes are not intended to move students ahead in the standard curriculum but rather to explore topics not usually covered in the K-8 classroom.

- Each class session is 50 minutes, and meets 8 Saturdays a quarter. Our schedule allows students to take up to 3 classes a quarter.
- Tuition per class: \$225 with a **non-refundable** \$25 registration fee. Tuition waived for students qualifying for Free/Reduced Lunch.
- There are no qualification requirements for Saturday programs.

### Summer Challenge

#### GRADES 5-6

Summer Challenge is an academically advanced summer program for children who will have completed the 5th or 6th grade. Summer Challenge provides motivated students with an intensive, hands-on, fun, and educational experience in areas outside of the traditional school curriculum.

- The program runs for three weeks, five days a week, 9:00am-2:20pm. The Robinson Center offers before-class and after-class care.
- Tuition: \$1,100 with a **non-refundable** \$50 registration fee. There is an additional materials & excursions fee of \$75 – \$100, depending on the class. Tuition is waived for students qualifying for Free/Reduced Lunch.

### Summer Stretch

#### GRADES 7-10

(Not all classes are open to all grades.)

Summer Stretch offers both accelerated courses (e.g. Algebra 1 & 2, Geometry, Precalculus, Chemistry) and courses for enrichment (e.g. American Literature, Speech and Debate, Physics of Robotics). All of these courses provide an in-depth, intensive learning experience.

- The program runs for five weeks, three days a week (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday), 9:00am-2:20pm.
- Tuition: \$1,000 plus a materials & excursion fee of \$75 - \$100, depending on the class. There is a **non-refundable** \$50 registration fee.
